



FROM THE ACTING DIRECTOR
BUREAU OF THE CENSUS

About a year ago, the Census Bureau contacted you for the Survey of Program Dynamics. Within a few days, a field representative will contact you again to update the information we collected during our last visit. We will also ask some new questions about:

- Children's Well-being, Child Support
- Medical Expenses/Utilization of Health Care
- Education Enrollment

In addition, if you have children 12 to 17 years old in your household, we will conduct a separate interview with them, asking about their attitudes and behaviors on topics, such as household chores, school work, family relations, social interaction, and substance use.

Because your answers represent thousands of other households in the United States, your cooperation is a distinct service to your country. We will use this information to evaluate how welfare reforms are affecting the U.S. population and to see how people are meeting their everyday expenses. Your continued participation is extremely important to ensure the completeness and accuracy of the results. Although answering the questions is voluntary, each unanswered question lessens the accuracy of the data.

We are conducting the survey under the authority of Title 13, United States Code, Section 182. This law requires us to keep all information about you and your household strictly confidential. We may use this information only for statistical purposes and only in ways that no one can identify you as an individual.

It is important that we obtain the most accurate information possible so that we have a complete picture of the results of the economic situation of the people throughout the Nation and the impact of welfare legislation. You can help us by referring to your records (for example, bank statements and pay stubs) when answering the questions. This will also reduce the time required for the interview.

On the other side of this letter are the answers to questions most frequently asked about this survey.

We hope you will continue to participate in this important and useful survey, and we thank you in advance for your cooperation. The Census Bureau is grateful to you for your help.
